(This, of course, could vary with the arrival time at a campsite and the scheduled departure time the next morning). We especially ask you to keep others in mind and so allow everyone to obtain sufficient sleep.

Lastly, share your company with others. Talk and walk with others. When you stop for a meal do not set yourself apart from the group. The Club needs your help, your co-operation and your personality to survive......
