INCORPORATION OF THE CLUB

As members will be aware the Club is considering becoming incorporated.

Some of the Benefits to be obtained from incorporation are.

1. The ability of an incorporated association to sue and be sued in its own name.
2. The ability of an incorporated association to hold property in its corporate name without the necessity of appointing trustees.
3. The ability of an incorporated association to enter into contracts in its corporate name.
4. The liabilities of an incorporated association are enforceable against the association and not against the committee members personally.

SOME OF THE DISADVANTAGES ARE

1. Red Tape - Yearly return to the Justice Department.
2. Cost (minimal)
3. More work for the Secretary (minimal)

THE PROCEDURES TO BECOME INCORPORATED ARE

1. The members must, at a General Meeting -
 - (a) by special resolution, resolve to apply for incorporation of the association.
 - (b) by resolution, appoint a person to prepare the relevant application;
 - (c) determine the name under which they intend to apply for incorporation and two (2) alternative names;
 - (d) determine the rules which the association wishes to adopt.

INCORPORATION OF THE CLUB (Con't)

2. The person appointed to prepare the application for incorporation should complete an application form which includes a statutory declaration verifying the passing of the resolutions previously mentioned. The name, address, occupation and signature of each existing committee member must be included in the form.
3. The application form should be forwarded to the Under Secretary, Department of Justice and be accompanied by the following:-
 - (a) A copy of the last annual report and statement of the financial affairs of the association.
 - (b) Details of all land and improvements owned or proposed to be acquired by the association.
 - (c) The names and present addresses of all trustees registered as proprietors of any land owned by the association. If any such trustee is deceased or incapable of acting or unwilling to act, full details should be provided.
 - (d) The prescribed fee. Note: In most cases an association will be requested to advertise its application in the press. Applicants may also be required to give explanations or furnish further particulars concerning the application.
4. In cases where an association is already formed and wishes to maintain its present rules which may not prescribe certain mandatory rules or matters, it will be in order for the association to lodge a copy of its present rules together with a statement setting out the particular model rules it intends to adopt to comply with the legislation. This may obviate the need for the association to have its rules reprinted prior to incorporation.

Upon incorporation a certificate will be issued and we will have a common seal. Change of rules must be approved by the Under Secretary. To become incorporated our constitution must contain certain information as contained in the association incorporation Act and Regulations. The following amendments will be required to bring own constitution to conform with the model Rules.

Section 7 Membership

(xii) to be added

The number of members shall be unlimited.

Section 7 Membership

(xiii) to be added

- (a) The General Committee shall cause a Register to be kept in which shall be entered the names and residential addresses of all persons admitted to membership of the Club and the dates of their admission.
- (b) Particulars shall also be entered into the Register of deaths, resignations, terminations and reinstatements of membership and any further particulars as the General Committee or the members of any general meeting may require from time to time.
- (c) The Register shall be open for inspection at all reasonable times by any member who previously applies to the secretary for such inspection.

Section 11 General Committee
 (viii) to be added

Common Seal

The General Committee shall provide for a Common Seal and for its safe custody. The Common Seal shall only be used by the authority of the General Committee and every instrument to which the seal is affixed shall be signed by a member of the General Committee and shall be countersigned by the secretary or by a second member of the General Committee or by some other person appointed by the General Committee for the purpose.

Section 11 General Committee
 (ix) to be added

The secretary shall cause full and accurate minutes of all questions, matters, resolutions and other proceedings of every General Committee meeting and general meeting to be entered in a book to be open for inspection at all reasonable times by any financial member who previously applies to the secretary for that inspection. For the purposes of ensuring the accuracy of the recording of such minutes, the minutes of every General Committee meeting shall be signed by the Chairman of that meeting or the Chairman of the next succeeding General Committee meeting verifying their accuracy. Similarly, the minutes of every general meeting shall be signed by the Chairman of that meeting or the Chairman of the next succeeding general meeting: Provided that the minutes of any annual general meeting shall be signed by the Chairman of that meeting or the Chairman of the next succeeding general meeting or annual general meeting.

Section 21 Amendments to constitution
 2 to be added

Subject to the provisions of the Associations Incorporation Act 1981, these Rules may be amended, rescinded or added to from time to time by a special resolution carried at any general meeting: Provided that no such amendments, rescission or addition shall be valid unless the same shall have been previously submitted to and approved by the Under Secretary, Department of Justice, Brisbane.

Section 9 Finance
 (vii) to be added

Documents

The Management Committee shall provide for the safe custody of books, documents, instruments of title and securities of the Club.

(viii) to be added

The income and property of the Club whencesoever derived shall be used and applied solely in promotion of its objects and in the exercise of its powers as set out herein and no portion thereof shall be distributed, paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit to or amongst the members of the Club provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of interest to any such member in respect of moneys advanced by him to the Club or otherwise owing by the Club to him or of remuneration to any officers or servants of the Club or to any member of the Club or other person in return for any services actually rendered to the Club provided further that nothing herein contained shall be construed so as to prevent money lent, reasonable and proper charges for goods hired by the Club or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised or let to the Club.

JANUARY 1984PAGE 10INCORPORATION OF THE CLUB (Con't)Section 23 to be added

If the Club is to be wound up and their remains after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever it shall be paid to the Archbishop of Brisbane for distribution as he sees fit.

Section 10 Trustees to be deleted.

A motion will be moved at the next meeting as follows:

That the Brisbane Catholic Bushwalking become incorporated and that David Mort prepare the relevant application. The name under which we intend to become incorporated be (i) Brisbane Catholic Bushwalking Club inc. or (ii) The Brisbane Catholic Bushwalking Club inc or (iii) Brisbane Catholic Walking Club inc. The rules of the Club be as per the constitution plus amendments as mentioned and any other amendments considered necessary by the Under Secretary, Department of Justice.
