PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CONSTITUTION Moved Denise Thompson
Seconded Russell Nelson

To be tabled at the February General Meeting and voted on at the March General Meeting. Any proposed amendments to the motion must be forwarded in writing to the General Secretary within 14 days after the February General Meeting and must bear the signature of two members entitled to vote.

New Section 7(ix)

Associate membership shall be available to non-catholics who will be entitled to attend all club functions. Associate membership will be 2/3rds. ordinary subscription. Associate members will not have voting rights and shall not be eligible to stand for Committee or sub-committee."

Section 7(iii) to be altered to read -

"Membership shall be divided into Prospective, Ordinary and Associate Membership. Prospective members are all applicants who have not yet completed the probationary period of 3 months."

The following amendments are also necessary if the new Section 7(ix) is carried. The following amendments are moved by Denise Thompson and seconded by Marnie Conway.

Section 7(i) to be altered to read -

"Ordinary membership is limited to persons who are Catholics. For the purpose of this clause married couples shall be regarded as eligible where one partner is a Catholic."

Section 7(vi) to be altered to read -

"The Committee shall receive and deal with all reports, complaints and charges concerning members or associate members. Where it considers that a member or associate member has offended against the best interests of the Club, the Committee may expel or suspend for a duration to be decided by the Committee such member or associate member, provided that he shall have right of appeal to a General Meeting. At such General meeting such appeal shall be upheld if more than one-third of members entitled to vote, vote in his favour."

Section 7(vii) to be altered to read -

"The Club or its agents does not accept any liability for injury, loss or damage, suffered or caused by any Member, Prospective Member, Associate Member or visitor whilst participating in the club's activities."

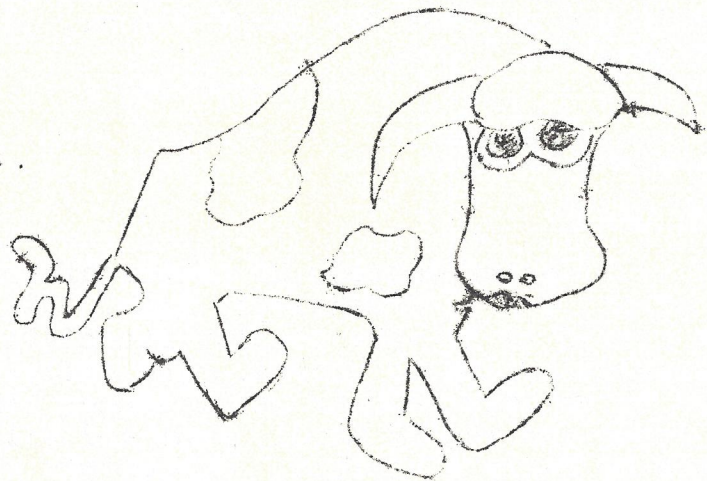
