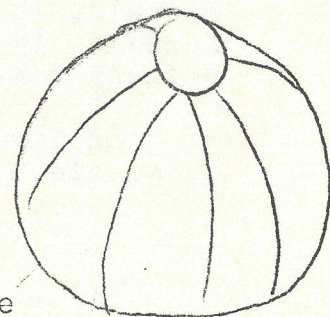

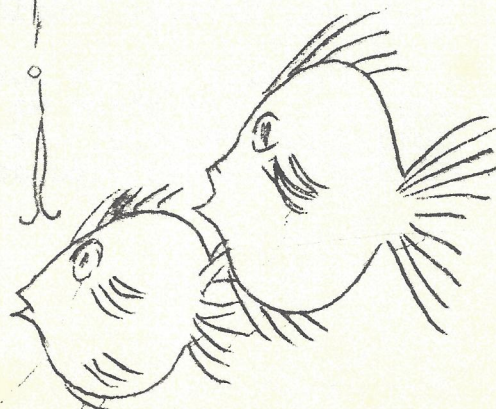
# BEACH PICNIC POINT LOOKOUT

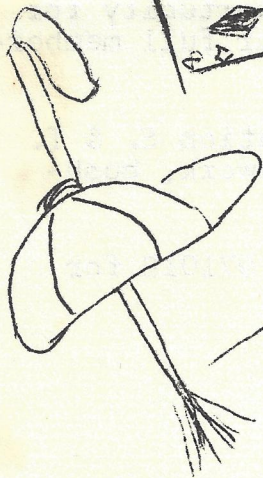
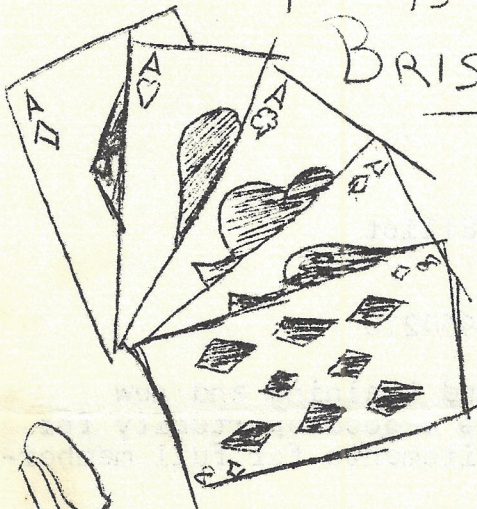

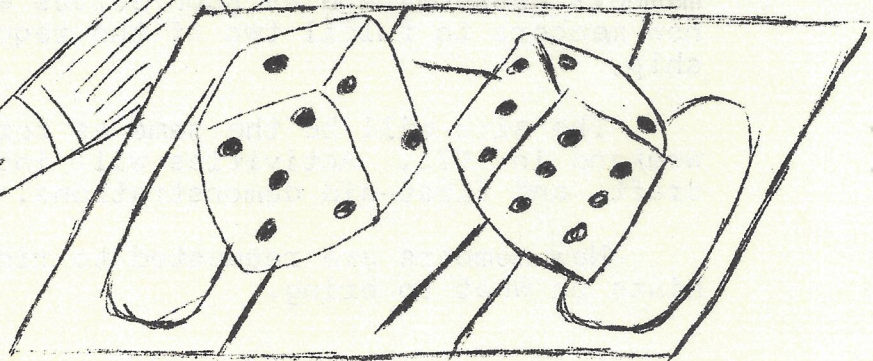
