

Being an Emergency Officer can be very difficult when an anxious parent rings up on Sunday night at 9.01 p.m. and nothing has been heard from the appointed trip leader. In recent history, a search party was about to leave Brisbane to look for walkers just as the missing walkers reached their beds.

Therefore, it is essential that trip leaders ring the Emergency Officer by 9.00 p.m. at the very latest. Occasionally, this may require an S.T.D. call or trunk call. This implies that the leader should have an adequate supply of 20 cent pieces.

So next time you lead a trip, don't forget the Emergency Officer.

EQUIPMENT HIRE
